## March 10<sup>th</sup> Deadline to Comment on Injury Tracking Proposed Rule

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has announced that the comment period on the proposed rule to improve workplace safety and health through improved tracking of workplace injuries and illnesses will close on March 10, 2014.

The proposed rule would amend OSHA's recordkeeping regulations to add requirements for the electronic submission of injury and illness information that employers are already required to keep.
